1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. This EXHIBIT C – FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS aims to:

1.1.1. Present information on the delivery flow and documentation related to the furniture and equipment of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS, specifically detailing the guidelines related to the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ); and

1.1.2. Present the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN, which establishes the guidelines for the list of equipment and furniture to be acquired by the CONCESSIONAIRE to equip the EDUCATIONAL UNITS for their proper operation throughout the entire CONCESSION TERM.

1.2. For omitted cases, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall request guidance from the GRANTING AUTHORITY.

1.3. The GRANTING AUTHORITY may, at any time, when determined that the CONCESSIONAIRE has failed to comply with the obligations established in this document, expressly require that the necessary adjustments and adaptations be made.

1.4. Throughout the CONCESSION TERM, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall comply with all minimum and specific requirements of the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN specified in this EXHIBIT.

1.4.1. The furniture and equipment mentioned in the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN are referential, except for the minimum specifications regarding dimensions, quantities, volumetry, technical and functional requirements. The CONCESSIONAIRE shall comply with these minimum specifications.

1.5. Unless expressly provided otherwise in this EXHIBIT, capitalized terms not otherwise defined shall have the same meanings assigned to them in the AGREEMENT, in accordance with EXHIBIT I – GLOSSARY, and the AGREEMENT provisions regarding the interpretation of these defined terms shall equally apply.

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 2.1.** The CONCESSIONAIRE shall submit, for each of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS, the following documents, in accordance with the deadlines set forth in this EXHIBIT and in compliance with the stages described in the MACRO IMPLEMENTATION SCHEDULE, the WORKS IMPLEMENTATION PLAN, and EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS:

 - 2.1.1.** Existing Furniture and Equipment Relocation Plan;
 - 2.1.2.** Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ); and
 - 2.1.3.** REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENT, including and highlighting the Furniture and Equipment List.
- 2.2.** The CONCESSIONAIRE shall submit the Furniture and Equipment Relocation Plan of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS to the INDEPENDENT VERIFIER and the GRANTING AUTHORITY within 30 (thirty) days as of the issuance of the ORDER TO COMMENCE.
- 2.3.** Once the Furniture and Equipment Relocation Plan has been submitted by the CONCESSIONAIRE, the INDEPENDENT VERIFIER shall issue its opinion within 10 (ten) days, as set forth in EXHIBIT G – INDEPENDENT VERIFIER GUIDELINES.
- 2.4.** Following the opinion of the INDEPENDENT VERIFIER, the GRANTING AUTHORITY shall have a period of 30 (thirty) days to approve the plan and/or determine any adjustments.

 - 2.4.1.** If the GRANTING AUTHORITY does not issue a requirement for adjustments within the indicated period, the Existing Furniture and Equipment Relocation Plan shall be deemed definitively approved.
- 2.5.** If adjustments are required, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall implement the necessary changes within 15 (fifteen) days for a new evaluation by the GRANTING AUTHORITY.
- 2.6.** Once the indicated adjustments have been made, the GRANTING AUTHORITY shall have 5 (five) days to grant final approval of the document.
- 2.7.** The Existing Furniture and Equipment Relocation Plan shall govern:

 - 2.7.1.** The procedure for the separation, preparation, and transportation of the furniture and equipment currently installed in the EDUCATIONAL UNITS

which, under the RELOCATION SCENARIO TO A TEMPORARY STRUCTURE (Shared or Dedicated), shall be relocated to the TEMPORARY STRUCTURE, in accordance with the inventory of existing assets, consisting of the INVENTORY OF PRE-EXISTING FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT, reviewed by the CONCESSIONAIRE, as provided in EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS; and

2.7.2.The procedure for the separation, preparation, and transportation of the furniture and equipment currently installed in the EDUCATIONAL UNITS which, under the INTERNAL RELOCATION SCENARIO, shall be relocated from each environment undergoing works to a temporary environment and returned to the original environment upon completion of the works in that environment, in accordance with the inventory of existing assets, consisting of the INVENTORY OF PRE-EXISTING FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT, reviewed by the CONCESSIONAIRE, as provided in EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.

2.7.3.The procedure for the separation, preparation, and transportation of the furniture and equipment currently installed in the EDUCATIONAL UNITS which, under the RELOCATION SCENARIO with PARTIAL TEMPORARY STRUCTURE, shall be relocated from each environment undergoing works to the PARTIAL TEMPORARY STRUCTURE and returned to the original environment upon completion of the works in that environment, in accordance with the inventory of existing assets, consisting of the INVENTORY OF PRE-EXISTING FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT, reviewed by the CONCESSIONAIRE, as provided in EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.

2.8. Once the REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENT has been approved by the GRANTING AUTHORITY, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall assume responsibility for the custody, maintenance and/or replacement of the furniture and equipment installed in the EDUCATIONAL UNITS, in accordance with this EXHIBIT, the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN, the AGREEMENT, and EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.

2.9. The existing furniture and equipment of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS whose operation will be transferred to the CONCESSIONAIRE after the issuance of the NOTICE TO PROCEED shall be fully replaced by the CONCESSIONAIRE, as provided in the

Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ), during the WORKS STAGE, in accordance with this EXHIBIT and EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.

2.10. The CONCESSIONAIRE shall submit the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) to the GRANTING AUTHORITY within 30 (thirty) days as of the start date of the WORKS STAGE of each EDUCATIONAL UNIT, in accordance with the guidelines of the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN and the general provisions of this EXHIBIT, as well as EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.

2.10.1. The CONCESSIONAIRE shall include in the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ), in addition to the furniture for the respective environments, all urban furniture for the external areas within the EDUCATIONAL UNIT (such as drinking fountains, waste bins and benches).

2.10.2. The proportion of urban furniture for the external areas is indicated in the PROGRAM OF REQUIREMENTS and in the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN, on a referential basis.

2.10.3. Once the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) has been submitted, the GRANTING AUTHORITY shall issue its opinion, either approving it or specifying any necessary corrections or additions, within a maximum period of 30 (thirty) days.

2.10.3.1. If corrections or additions to the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) for the EDUCATIONAL UNITS are requested by the GRANTING AUTHORITY, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall implement them and resubmit the plan within a maximum period of 15 (fifteen) days.

2.10.3.2. In the event of resubmission of the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) by the CONCESSIONAIRE, pursuant to the preceding subitem, the GRANTING AUTHORITY shall approve it within a maximum period of 5 (five) days.

2.10.4. The CONCESSIONAIRE shall be responsible for the acquisition and implementation of all furniture and equipment for all internal and external environments of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS, in accordance with the Furniture

and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) previously approved by the GRANTING AUTHORITY.

2.10.4.1. The implementation of all furniture and equipment shall take place by the end of the WORKS STAGE, pursuant to this EXHIBIT and EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.

2.11. Within 30 (thirty) days counted from the date of issuance of the NOTICE TO PROCEED of each EDUCATIONAL UNIT, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall submit the REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENT (highlighting the Furniture and Equipment List) of the respective EDUCATIONAL UNIT to the EDUCATIONAL UNIT MANAGER and to the GRANTING AUTHORITY, pursuant to this EXHIBIT and EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.

2.12. The CONCESSIONAIRE shall prepare and keep updated the REVERSIBLE ASSETS INVENTORY , which shall encompass all EDUCATIONAL UNITS, as established in the AGREEMENT and in this EXHIBIT.

3. GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR FURNITURE

3.1. The implementation of the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) by the CONCESSIONAIRE shall cover the entire EDUCATIONAL UNIT prior to the completion of the WORKS STAGE.

3.2. Whether through the implementation of new structures or the refurbishment of existing structures, or through the replacement of furniture at the end of its REMAINING USEFUL LIFE, the guidelines set forth in the following items shall be observed.

3.2.1. The furniture to be installed shall comply with accessibility standards and, where applicable, shall consider specific equipment for children, at heights suitable for use by members of the SCHOOL COMMUNITY across different age groups.

3.2.2. In external areas, the quantity and location of the furniture to be installed shall consider the circulation of people, as well as efficiency and durability requirements.

3.2.3.The FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN shall set forth guidelines for the implementation of furniture in the external areas of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS.

3.2.4.In internal areas, the quantity and location of the furniture shall comply with the minimum references set forth in the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN, the minimum capacity of each environment, and the standards applicable to school environments, such as the specifications for the installation of school furniture issued by the FNDE.

3.2.5.The furniture provided shall, at a minimum, meet the requirements specified in the PROGRAM OF REQUIREMENTS.

3.2.6.Waste bins shall include selective collection units, with standardized and integrated visual identification, and their installation shall consider areas with the highest concentration of people.

3.2.7.The installation of drinking fountains shall follow the guidelines set forth in the PROGRAM OF REQUIREMENTS. Drinking fountains shall include access points suitable for persons with disabilities.

3.2.8.Upon implementation of the furniture, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall provide the services of installation, configuration, integration and operation of all equipment, to ensure performance and reliability compatible with the intended applications of each type of equipment, thereby enabling compliance with the PERFORMANCE INDICATORS set forth in EXHIBIT E – PERFORMANCE INDICATORS.

3.3. The CONCESSIONAIRE shall size and maintain a contingency stock of furniture to ensure the following needs:

- a) Replacement in the event of damage, breakage, or unplanned shutdown of furniture and equipment;
- b) Replacement of equipment due to malfunction issues (recurring failures) and low and/or irregular performance, inadequate or non-compliant with the specifications of the respective manufacturer; and
- c) Use of furniture and equipment by members of the SCHOOL COMMUNITY to ensure continuity of activities during preventive maintenance.

3.3.1. The sizing of the contingency stock shall consider the probability of equipment failure or breakage and the criticality of such equipment for the performance of activities within the CONCESSION AREA.

3.4. The CONCESSIONAIRE shall, whenever necessary, carry out the renewal of equipment, especially information and communication technology (ICT) infrastructure assets and high-wear items, such as sports infrastructure, to keep them continuously updated and operational, considering equipment compatibility and interoperability, as well as the operational requirements of the different types of solutions used.

3.5. In the acquisition of the equipment that makes up the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ), the CONCESSIONAIRE shall, whenever applicable, require the PROCEL label – National Electric Energy Conservation Program – and the INMETRO label – National Institute of Metrology, Standardization and Industrial Quality.

4. FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT PLAN (PME-ARQ)

4.1. The Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) consists on the presentation of information regarding furniture, equipment or electrical and electronic devices, when required for their acquisition for installation or replacement.

4.2. The Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) to be submitted by the CONCESSIONAIRE shall contain, at a minimum, the following items:

- a) Code and name of the furniture item, equipment or electrical/electronic device;
- b) Description of the item, including material, finishes, technical specifications, voltage, power and electrical current specifications (when applicable);
- c) Item dimensions (width x depth x height), when applicable; and
- d) Supplier and price of the item.

4.3. The furniture, equipment or electrical and electronic devices presented by the CONCESSIONAIRE in the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) shall prioritize user ergonomics and comply with the applicable standards.

- 4.4.** For the preparation of the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ), the CONCESSIONAIRE shall observe the FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN and, where applicable, consider the standards and regulations applicable to the furniture and equipment of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS, such as:
- a) NBR 14006: Establishes minimum requirements for individual student sets, consisting of desk and chair, for educational institutions at all levels, regarding ergonomic aspects, finishing, identification, stability and strength.
 - b) ABNT NBR ISO 11226: Ergonomics – Evaluation of static working postures;
 - c) ABNT NBR 9050: Accessibility; and
 - d) Technical catalogs of school furniture issued by the National Fund for the Development of Education (FNDE).
- 4.5.** The furniture installed in the EDUCATIONAL UNITS shall have dimensions suitable to provide ergonomic conditions for the age groups for which they are intended and shall provide adequate space or furniture for persons with disabilities, as required, in all educational spaces.
- 4.6.** The CONCESSIONAIRE shall identify the environments that require drinking fountains, as well as the proportion of drinking fountain points for each space. The Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) shall include these specifications and proportions.
- 4.7.** Upon submission of the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ), the CONCESSIONAIRE may request changes to the minimum specifications set forth in this EXHIBIT, provided that a proper justification is submitted, which shall be subject to analysis by the GRANTING AUTHORITY.
- 4.7.1.** The analysis by the GRANTING AUTHORITY of the requests referred to in the preceding subitem shall be carried out in accordance with the deadlines set forth in subitem 2.10.3.
- 4.8.** The CONCESSIONAIRE shall be free to determine how to prepare the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ), and may provide products and equipment from different manufacturers and models, providing they comply with technical standards, applicable legislation, and the minimum performance, safety and quality requirements described in this EXHIBIT.

- 4.9.** If a specific brand or model is mentioned, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall understand that such reference serves solely as an indication of the minimum quality and/or functionality required of the product to be supplied.
- 4.10.** The CONCESSIONAIRE shall consider and minimize any impacts on layout, interoperability, ergonomics, functionality, safety and aesthetics of the environment when proposing furniture and equipment.
- 4.11.** In addition to complying with the mandatory minimum specifications detailed in this EXHIBIT, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall ensure that the equipment and furniture are compatible with the infrastructure and the SERVICES in the EDUCATIONAL UNITS.
- 4.12.** In preparing the Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ), the CONCESSIONAIRE shall also observe the general design parameters of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS, including the internal electrical power supply standards.
- 4.13.** The Furniture and Equipment Plan (PME-ARQ) shall be reviewed every 5 (five) years, during the ordinary review procedure described in the AGREEMENT, considering the need to ensure the TECHNOLOGICAL UPDATE of equipment and electrical and electronic devices.

5. OBLIGATIONS OF THE CONCESSIONAIRE

- 5.1.** With respect to furniture and equipment, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall:
- i. Ensure that all furniture and equipment included in the Furniture and Equipment Plan and specified in the REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENT submitted by the CONCESSIONAIRE are replaced in the event of deterioration, destruction, robbery, theft, loss or any other type of damage not covered by the insurance policies contracted by the CONCESSIONAIRE or by the manufacturer's warranty, in compliance with the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this EXHIBIT, the AGREEMENT, and EXHIBIT J – RISK ALLOCATION MATRIX;
 - ii. Ensure that all furniture and equipment of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS for which the respective OPERATION ORDERS have been issued are available and in perfect working condition to allow the proper operation of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS throughout the CONCESSION TERM;

- iii. Ensure that all furniture and equipment of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS listed in the REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENT, as approved by the GRANTING AUTHORITY for the respective EDUCATIONAL UNITS, are replaced in the event of deterioration, destruction, robbery, theft, loss or any other type of damage not covered by the insurance policies contracted by the CONCESSIONAIRE or by the manufacturer's warranty, in compliance with the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this EXHIBIT, the AGREEMENT, and EXHIBIT J – RISK ALLOCATION MATRIX;
- iv. Keep the furniture and equipment operating with adequate quality and functionality to enable compliance with the PERFORMANCE INDICATORS established in EXHIBIT E – PERFORMANCE INDICATORS;
- v. Ensure compliance with the operation and maintenance requirements stipulated for each piece of equipment, in accordance with the instructions provided by the manufacturer and/or supplier;
- vi. Maintain an up-to-date report recording occurrences of equipment malfunction, describing: the equipment concerned, the issue identified, the date on which the fault was detected, the date on which the issue was corrected, and the solution implemented;
- vii. Ensure the technical, ergonomic and aesthetic quality of furniture and equipment used in the outfitting of EDUCATIONAL UNITS that serve children up to 5 (five) years of age;
- viii. Ensure the compatibility of the dimensions and volumes of furniture and equipment within the EDUCATIONAL UNITS;
- ix. Acquire new equipment and furniture or replace or replenish them with the same quality and specifications presented in the Furniture and Equipment Plan prepared by the CONCESSIONAIRE, and, at the time of acquiring new equipment, provide for the corresponding update based on the equivalent model available at that time.

6. REVERSIBLE ASSETS INVENTORY

- 6.1.** The CONCESSIONAIRE is responsible for preparing and keeping the REVERSIBLE ASSETS INVENTORY updated, including the works, installations, and all furniture and equipment of the EDUCATIONAL UNITS.

- 6.2.** The REVERSIBLE ASSETS INVENTORY shall be consolidated and updated based on the list of REVERSIBLE ASSETS set forth in each REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENT approved, in accordance with the provisions of EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS.
- 6.2.1.** The inventory shall include the REVERSIBLE ASSETS of all EDUCATIONAL UNITS for which the respective OPERATION ORDERS have been issued and the corresponding REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENTS have been approved, segregated by EDUCATIONAL UNIT.
- 6.2.2.** The CONCESSIONAIRE shall update the INVENTORY by incorporating the list of REVERSIBLE ASSETS from each REVERTIBLE ASSETS LISTING INSTRUMENT that is approved, to reflect their respective allocation to the SERVICES, in compliance with the provisions of this EXHIBIT, EXHIBIT A – SCHEDULE OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORKS, and the AGREEMENT.
- 6.3.** The CONCESSIONAIRE shall prepare, on an annual basis, a list of REVERSIBLE ASSETS, as provided in the AGREEMENT.
- 6.4.** With respect to furniture and equipment, it shall be the responsibility of the CONCESSIONAIRE to indicate in the INVENTORY:
- a) Code and name of the furniture item, equipment or electrical/electronic device;
 - b) Description of the item, including material, finishes, technical specifications, voltage, power and electrical current specifications (when applicable);
 - c) Item dimensions (width x depth x height), when applicable; and
 - d) Supplier of the item.
- 6.5.** With respect to asset cataloging, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall affix asset identification tags, which may follow, by way of example, barcodes (binary code), QR Codes (2D graphics), RFID (radio frequency identification systems) or any existing or commercially available equivalent system, if it is suitable for asset control purposes.
- 6.6.** Among the information contained in the REVERSIBLE ASSETS INVENTORY, the CONCESSIONAIRE shall, at a minimum, provide:

6.6.1.For buildings: asset identification code, building location, engineering and architectural designs, as-built documentation and BIM methodology documents, similar or equivalent, if produced by the CONCESSIONAIRE, as well as other records and documents required for the building in accordance with applicable legislation;

6.6.2.For equipment, furniture and other movable assets: asset identification code, brand, model, asset description, state of conservation, serial number, year of manufacture, among others.

6.7. The GRANTING AUTHORITY may request the submission of an updated INVENTORY and conduct inspections of the REVERSIBLE ASSETS to assess their operational condition.

7. FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT REFERENCE PLAN

7.1. The furniture and equipment presented in the tables below have been defined on a referential basis, encompassing descriptions, specifications and quality. These values served as parameters for the calculation per square meter within the selected typologies and their derivatives, functioning as a comparative reference rather than as a definition of mandatory minimum quantities.

7.2. The CONCESSIONAIRE may propose products and quality levels different from those indicated, if they are previously approved by the GRANTING AUTHORITY, and shall adopt specifications that are appropriate and sufficient to comply with the PERFORMANCE INDICATORS.
